

## CLICK, PARK, AND PICK-UP AT THE CORONA PUBLIC LIBRARY

Have you missed your library books? They miss you! Beginning Tuesday, May 26<sup>th</sup>, Corona Public Library's materials are available for check out through Click, Park, and Pick-Up. They've been sitting patiently on the shelves yearning to be read and watched again.

Do you know exactly what you would like to read or watch? Search the catalog and request those specific titles by placing a hold on them or give us a call at 951.736.2384.

Would you prefer us to surprise you? Use the Grab & Go Bag option for picture books to chapter books. Place a hold on the Grab & Go Bag of your choice and staff will choose a selection of items for you.

**Click:** Use our library catalog to place holds on library materials. Staff will pull your requests and then contact you to arrange your Pick-Up time! Please do not go to the Library before you schedule a Pick-Up time.

**Park & Pick-Up:** Visit the Library at your scheduled pick-up time, park, and follow the signs to the Pick-Up location in front of the Library.

**Safety First!** Please return any items currently checked out to one of the three Book Drops outside the Library. From the book drop, items will be removed and quarantined for 72 hours before checked-in and made available for use.



All staff are practicing suggested precautions against the COVID-19 virus and utilizing masks, gloves, and regular sanitizing of surfaces. Please note that Pick-Up is organized to provide for social distancing, and face masks should be worn per Riverside County Public Health and State of California recommendations.
